





Woodland Elementary School in the East Syracuse Minoa Central School District, has proudly implemented Primary Project in grades K-3 for over 13 years. This success is made possible through a strong partnership with Contact Community Services (CCS), along with the dedication of a mental health supervisor and a skilled child associate.

Student Snapshot

214 students were screened in the 2024-2025 school year using the Teacher Child-Rating Scale (T-CRS), an assessment tool designed to support student social-emotional and behavioral growth.

41 students were selected to participate in Primary Project based on T-CRS data.

Outcomes

71%	demonstrated improved social skills
74%	demonstrated academic gains
71%	demonstrated improved emotional skills
95%	maintained or improved attendance
90%	maintained or decreased
