



PARENT-CHILD RATING SCALE (P-CRS)

Parent completed measure of children's social-emotional adjustment

Highlights:

- Provides an assessment from the parent's perspective of children's social-emotional status while learning may occur remotely from school.
- Offers valuable input for teachers and other school-based staff.
- Facilitates communication between home and school more effectively.
- Can be used as a screening tool as well as an outcome measure (pre/post) for students in pre-K through third grade.
- May be used in conjunction with the Teacher-Child Rating Scale (T-CRS) or independently.

Reliably assesses 7 areas of social-emotional development:

| Domain | Alpha Reliability Coefficient |
|-----------------------------|-------------------------------|
| Positive Peer Social Skills | .85 |
| Task Orientation | .80 |
| Disposition | .78 |
| Shy anxious/Withdrawn | .75 |
| Assertive Social Skills | .76 |
| Frustration Tolerance | .76 |
| Negative Peer Social Skills | .76 |
