

Short

Only 32 items (4, 8-item sub-scales) - Can be completed in 3 to 4 minutes

Strength-based social and emotional screening tool

Reliable

Alpha reliabilities range from .87-.94

Valid

Highly correlated with similar scales from the Achenbach Teacher Report Form

Four domains:

- Externalized behavior/Behavior control
- Internalized behavior/Assertiveness
- Peer social skills
- Task orientation

Possibilities for use – The T-CRS and RtI:

Screening and Tier 1

- Screen all children's socio-emotional strengths and weaknesses
- Compare results to national norms
- Identify children's competencies and needs for services

Assessment for Tier 2 & Tier 3

- Assess socio-emotional adjustment over time (pre/post, multiple times)
- Evaluate Tier 2 program effectiveness
- Measure progress of almost any intervention

Evaluation

- Assess psycho-educational components for special education placement
- Monitor students' behavioral progress
- Aggregate and analyze results at the group level




